CMFCAA serves 13 counties and volunteer opportunities vary by region.

Light Support **Technical Support**

Event Coordination/ Prep Volunteers with relevant skills would help support CMFCAA staff at events.

Volunteer would use specific skills to help set up for events ie: cooking, decorating, etc.

As needed, on an event basis

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Medium Support **Clothing Closet**

Older Youth Finance Mentor

In-Service Training Childcare Volunteer Volunteer would help sort, organize and hang the clothing that has been donated.

Volunteer would help older youth with purchasing decisions as needed and/ or teach a 1 hour finance class

Volunteer would do specific activities with children and youth ages 0-16

Ongoing

As needed and/or quarterly for 1 hour

Once a month, for 2 hours

Heavy Support Respite Childcare Volunteer

Transitions Mentor

Investment Partnership/ Advocacy Volunteer would provide care at a respite event for children and youth ages 0-18

Volunteer would be matched one-onone with an older youth and mentor (life skills education, college, etc) them their senior year high school

Volunteers can advocate to support investments for CMFCAA and can interface with stakeholders to pursue product and monetary donations.

Once a month, for 4 hours

Meet with youth once a month, 1st year is a larger time commitment than the 2nd year

Ongoing

Volunteer requirements are dependent on the task.

All childcare/youth volunteers will need to complete
a background check.
