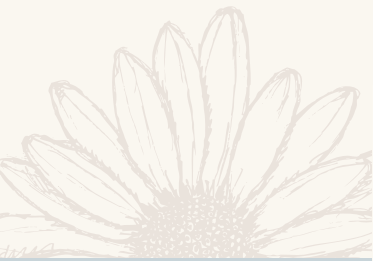


CMFCAA *Volunteer Opportunities*

BACKGROUND; A robust volunteer base is fundamental to the success of Central Missouri Foster Care and Adoption Association. Below is a description of the various opportunities for individuals (of all talents and skills) to contribute.
CMFCAA serves 13 counties and volunteer opportunities vary by region.



	Opportunity	Description	Commitment
Light Support	Technical Support	Volunteers with relevant skills would help support CMFCAA staff at events.	As needed, on an event basis
	Event Coordination/ Prep	Volunteer would use specific skills to help set up for events ie: cooking, decorating, etc.	As needed, on an event basis
Medium Support	Clothing Closet	Volunteer would help sort, organize and hang the clothing that has been donated.	Ongoing
	Older Youth Finance Mentor	Volunteer would help older youth with purchasing decisions as needed and/or teach a 1 hour finance class	As needed and/or quarterly for 1 hour
	In-Service Training Childcare Volunteer	Volunteer would do specific activities with children and youth ages 0-16	Once a month, for 2 hours
Heavy Support	Respite Childcare Volunteer	Volunteer would provide care at a respite event for children and youth ages 0-18	Once a month, for 4 hours
	Transitions Mentor	Volunteer would be matched one-on-one with an older youth and mentor (life skills education, college, etc) them their senior year high school	Meet with youth once a month, 1st year is a larger time commitment than the 2nd year
	Investment Partnership/ Advocacy	Volunteers can advocate to support investments for CMFCAA and can interface with stakeholders to pursue product and monetary donations.	Ongoing

Volunteer requirements are dependent on the task.
All childcare/youth volunteers will need to complete a background check.
